

Longitudinal / National Student Clearinghouse Data

- Currently, the only student-level college going data reports are only available to the Local School System's data office/ Superintendent's Office. The Superintendent's Office can choose to share this information with CTE Directors and/or individual schools.
- Each County's CTE Director currently receives a Program Quality Index (PQI) report annually, providing detailed data on every CTE program offered by their county. However, this is county, not school or student level data.
- The measure that equates to college going is Placement. This measure currently combines college going with employment and enlistment in the military. Our goal is within the next 2 years to be able to separate out the college going data through the LDS.
- Data security is another key point relative to all MSDE generated student data reports. Any data cell showing less than 10 students is masked. This is done in response to FERPA, the (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act) to eliminate the possibility of identifying individual students.
